**A Club who fails to appear on the day and has not given three days notice of their withdrawal to the General Secretary by Letter, E-Mail ([info@gui-ulster.co.uk](mailto:info@gui-ulster.co.uk)) or by Fax (028 9049 1615) shall incur a penalty of £100. Future entry to the Competition by the Club shall not be accepted until the penalty is paid in full.**

**Competition Rules:** A full set of rules is available in the Tournament Conditions Book circulated to Clubs or can be viewed on-line at [www.gui.ie/ulster](http://www.gui.ie/ulster).

**Handicap Qualification:** To be eligible to compete as a pair, the combined handicap shall not be lower than 19 with a maximum of 36. Handicap qualifying date Ladies and Gents lowest handicap in the previous calendar year. All players must be at least 18 years of age on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2012. Evidence of each player's eligibility must be produced both at the qualifying and at the match play stages, preferably using the single page GOLFNET report.

**Mode of Play:** Each team to consist of 5 male members and 5 lady members. Play shall be by foursome medal play with handicap allowance of ½ combined of current playing handicap with the best four cards from five to count. Men to drive at the first hole. Thirty-two teams will qualify for the match play stage - four from each section. The qualifying Clubs will return to their original venue, unless the home team qualifies and play in the following format 1 v 4, 2 v 3 following which an open draw will be made by the Ulster Branch who will also set the dates and venues for these matches to be played.

**Practice:** Teams to contact host Club beforehand. Green fees are payable. One practice round (at least) as if playing with a member. Team members to produce identification if requested.

**National Finals:** The National Final to determine the winner of the Irish Mixed Foursomes will be played at **Clontarf Golf Club on 6-7 September 2012.**
